Dear Students, Parents & Guardians

Attached is the subject selection form for Year 9 students in 2017. Please consult the 2017 Year 9 Elective Selection Handbook for an explanation of each elective course.

- Each elective course will run for either a semester (S) or for a full year (Y).
- Select either Physical Education or the Specialist Cricket Program in Semester 1 and Semester 2.
- To give a variety of experiences in all learning areas, students should select at least one elective from The Arts and one elective from Technologies.
- Not every elective will operate. This will depend upon the number of students who show interest in this elective course. Therefore, it is essential that you provide a first and second choice on each grid line.

Specialist Cricket Program:

The Cricket program is reserved for Year 9 students who have been selected for the program. This is a year-long course which counts for two elective choices. Students in the Cricket program must choose Cricket; then two other courses in each semester. Students in the Cricket program will be guaranteed this program on that line and do not have to complete a second choice.

Procedure

- Students select four electives for each semester. One of those must be Physical Education or Specialist Cricket Program.
- Students choose one elective course per line from the table on the attached form and write it in as your first choice.
- Students also write down a second choice.
- You and your parent/guardian must sign this form to confirm a change of choices.
- Please hand into the Main Office as soon as possible as places in courses will be offered on a first come first served basis.

NOTE: Parents and guardians should take note that charges for these options are compulsory and due to be paid in full by **Friday 3 March 2017**. There are a number of nil cost courses available in each learning area.
